The Friends of the Sunnyvale Public Library exists to provide public knowledge and use of the Sunnyvale Public Library's resources, services and programs; to encourage the growth and development of the library; and to strengthen and expand the appreciation of the corporation as a cultural and educational asset to the library and community. This organization was established in 2009. Through the years they have held galas, concerts and book sales to raise funds for the library. The Friends have provided items for the library such as the rug in the children's area, funded prizes of the Summer Reading Program and put aside a substantial amount of money to contribute to the needs of a future library.

Breakdown of Project Costs

The Doris Padgett Public Library is the jewel of Sunnyvale, but its limited space has kept it from offering more programming, services and more updated offerings of larger library facilities.

We have 4 main goals if we are fortunate enough to be awarded this grant: 1) reorganize the storage shed, 2) buy video equipment, 3) enhance library grounds and 4) redesign the front desk area.

First we would like to reorganize the storage shed to open it up for a work space that would be open to the public for such things as die cutting, laminating, and book binding. Total cost: \$5800 (New laminator and die cutter, storage

shelving and supplies for dies)

Second would be to buy video equipment to develop instructional videos, record presentations and to support the library's goal of compiling historical information about Sunnyvale which will later be recorded in a format to be shared with Sunnyvale citizens. At this time there is no documentation on the history of Sunnyvale and the high school will be getting the students involved with this project. (Cost of camera, microphone, and large storage hard drive: \$495)

Our 3rd goal is to enhance our outdoor space to encourage spending more time at the library by providing picnic tables on the grounds in front of the library. (Two picnic tables: \$1600)

Our 4th goal is to have a new desk made at the entrance to the library. The present desk was designed before the use of computers at the library so the staff needs a more functional configuration to meet our computer requirements. The custom design was utilized because of the constrained space for that area and traditional library furniture that was premade would not fit. (Estimated cost: \$7000)

We also intend to purchase a new Little Free Library to serve the community and facilitate book exchanges. Location to be determined (Cost: \$400)

Goal 1 - Reorganize storage shed

By adding shelving and some updated equipment this would allow the library to re-imagine that space so that it would expand what the library can offer.

Goal 2 - Video Equipment

The equipment would allow the staff to record such things as craft instructions and record presentations that people could access from home as was done this summer with the Summer Crafts Program. Also the history of Sunnyvale could be preserved by oral interviews with longtime Sunnyvale citizens and eventually put into a video for Sunnyvale citizens.

Goal 3 - Enhance Library Grounds

The library could become a destination for families to picnic while visiting the library, Moms and caregivers and children getting together after storytime, and outdoor book club gatherings.

Goal 4 - Redesign the Front Desk

With the new redesigned front desk it will not only be more functional for the staff, but the patrons will have the ease of returning their items to the library in a book drop which will also free up counter space for checking out books and conducting other business like applying for a library card.
